



She is far more precious than jewels. <sup>11</sup>The heart of her husband trusts in her, and he will have no lack of gain. <sup>12</sup>She does him good, and not harm, all the days of her life. <sup>13</sup>She seeks wool and flax, and works with willing hands. <sup>14</sup>She is like the ships of the merchant, she brings her food from far away. <sup>15</sup>She rises while it is still night and provides food for her household and tasks for her servant-girls. <sup>16</sup>She considers a field and buys it; with the fruit of her hands she plants a vineyard. <sup>17</sup>She girds herself with strength, and makes her arms strong. <sup>18</sup>She perceives that her merchandise is profitable. her clothing is fine linen and purple. <sup>23</sup>Her husband is known in the city gates, taking his seat among the elders of the land. <sup>24</sup>She makes linen garments and sells them; she supplies the merchant with sashes. <sup>25</sup>Strength and dignity are her clothing, and she laughs at the time to come. <sup>26</sup>She opens her mouth with wisdom, and the teaching of kindness is on her tongue. <sup>27</sup>She looks well to the ways of her household, and does not eat the bread of idleness.
